

## Millbrook Meadow

What is the best address to use to find your park, area, or trail?

Beach St, Rockport, MA (across from Front Beach)

**Is there parking available at this location?** Yes

**Is there a fee for parking? If yes, how much is parking?** On-street metered parking on Beach St or Main St; there is a ramp with sloping stairs on King St. between #19-21 for other access, but it does not have a handrail yet (coming in 2022)

**When is parking available?** 24 hours

**Is there lighting, such as street lamps, on this path?** No

**Is there clear signage marking the trails/paths?** Yes

**Are there benches along this path?** Yes

**Are public restrooms located near the trail or path?** Yes

**When are restrooms open (seasonally, during certain times of day)?** Restrooms are across the street at Front Beach, open seasonally

**Are restrooms wheelchair accessible?** Yes

**What type of setting is the path?** Public park

**Are multiple trails/paths available at this location?** No

**Are maps available? If yes, where can they be found?** This is a small 4 acre park with one trail running along the side. A map is not needed.

**Estimate the approximate length of the walk:** Walk will take 5-20 minutes depending on your speed

**What type of terrain?** Packed stone dust

**Is the path/trail accessible for those using a walker, wheelchair, or pushing a stroller?** Yes

**What is the grade of the walk?** Mostly flat with a slight incline towards the Mill Pond

**Rate the walk for level of exertion (1 = easy, 5 = difficult):** 1

**Describe the amount of activity at the site:** Moderate (frequently see people)

**What types of activities can be done at this location?** Walking; Running/jogging; Bird watching; Dog walking

**Summary:**

"Mill Pond is a pristine wonderland of aquatic plants, with turtles, eels, ducks, birds, otters, beavers, and fish.

The Meadow comprises the other half, an open space with a beautiful winding brook, a frog pond, native shade garden and delightful stone bridge plus a playground. It's a special place for play and relaxation. And a favorite spot for fairs and seasonal festivals. "

**Notable activities in the area:** All sorts of shopping and restaurants along Bearskin Neck, about half a mile away from Millbrook Meadow. Take a right out of the Meadow, follow Beach St, take a left on Main St. and the stores begin.

**Additional information:** This small gem of a park is worth visiting if making a trip to Rockport.
