

Norwood Pond Loop

Location: Entrance is at the end of Elnew Ave. off of Dodge St. Beverly, Ma.

What is the name of the park, area, or trail? Norwood Pond Loop

Is there parking available at this location? Yes

Is there a fee for parking? No fee.

When is parking available? I believe it is available 24 hours. It is in a neighborhood.

Is there lighting, such as street lamps, on this path? No

Is there clear signage marking the trails/paths? Yes

Are there benches along this path? No

Are public restrooms located near the trail or path? No

What type of setting is the path? Marsh

Are multiple trails/paths available at this location? Yes
