

Waterfront Park, Beverly

What is the best address to use to find your park, area, or trail? Waterfront Park, Elliot St behind McDonald's

Is there parking available at this location? Yes, plenty of parking behind the McDonald's lot; on the other end park behind the car wash on Bridge St.

Is there a fee for parking? No

When is parking available? No time restrictions on parking

Is there lighting, such as street lamps, on this path? No

Is there clear signage marking the trails/paths? No

Are there benches along this path? Yes

Are public restrooms located near the trail or path? No

What type of setting is the path? Sidewalk

Approximate length of the walk: Waterfront Park is 0.1 miles but you can extend the walk by going past the Bass Haven Yacht Club, heading right onto McPherson Drive and then walking along the river by Innocenti Park for a approximately 0.5 miles. Parking can be either at McDonald's on Elliott St or at the other end by the car wash on Bridge St.

What type of terrain? Paved

Is the path/trail accessible for those using a walker, wheelchair, or pushing a stroller? Yes

What is the grade of the walk? Flat

Rate the walk for level of exertion (1 = easy, 5 = difficult): 1

Amount of activity at the site: Moderate (frequently see people)

What types of activities can be done at this location? Walking, Running/jogging, Bird watching, Dog walking

Brief summary of the walk: Part of the walk showcases the Bass River which always looks better at high tide. The parking is easy and the walk is flat and paved and not too long. Part of the walk goes between the Bass Haven Yacht Club and the back of Stop and Shop, which is not as scenic.
